- Volunteers are required to register as a volunteer and at events which ensures compliance for insurance purposes.
- Volunteers must only undertake activities they are physically capable of and have the skills appropriate for the tasks to be undertaken.
- TreeLink Stirling will provide necessary resources and training sufficient to support projects and events.
- Volunteers may have reasonable expenses covered by TreeLink Stirling, provided costs have been pre-authorised by trustees.
- Treelink Stirling expects a high standard of behaviour from all participants in TreeLink activities. Details can be found in our Code of Conduct, along with information on what to do if you have any concerns.
- TreeLink will provide a safe environment with all information required to undertake any projects and activities in line with TreeLink Stirling's goals.
